

In January 2017, the Smilezone Team transformed TWO SMILEZONES in the Community Room and Art Room at Rachel's Kids House of Hope in Cornwall, ON. The House of Hope serves over 200+ children with autism and other sensory disorders and their siblings.



SCARBOROUGH AND ROUGE HOSPITAL





In January 2017, the Smilezone Team transformed SEVEN SMILEZONES at the Scarborough and Rouge Hospital in Scarborough, ON. Family waiting rooms, the day surgery area, the family maternity centre, playroom, and paediatric rapid assessment clinic were all transformed into new Smilezone spaces for over 2,500 children and families to enjoy.

In March 2017, the Smilezone Team transformed FOUR SMILEZONES at the Safehaven in Toronto, ON. The Main Area, Living Room, Teen Room, and hallway received a full Smilezone makeover, in partnership with the Toronto Rock. Over 200 children & youth with medically complex special needs enjoy the Smilezones on an annual basis.

"The living room is the hub of our respite facility. It's the first thing families see when they arrive, and where kids spend the vast majority of their time during their stay. After the Smilezone renovation, it is so much brighter and more inviting. You can see it in the eyes of new families, this is a space that looks warm and fun – it doesn't look institutional, which is so important. JOHN MCGIVNEY CHILDREN'S CENTRE





PATHSTONE MENTAL HEALTH





OTTAWA CHILDREN'S TREATMENT CENTRE SCHOOL










MASTERCARD MEMORIAL CUP

A YEAR OF SMILES INTEGRATION, INCLUSION & INNOVATION

INTEGRATION, INCLUSION & INNOVATION

Smilezone Foundation prides itself on ensuring each Zone we customize is fun, safe, and accessible to the diverse clientele that our organization serves. Each hospital or healthcare centre that Smilezone works completes a needs assessment before the design stage, providing our design team with in-depth information about the unique children and families they work with. It is this level of communication and customization that sets Smilezone apart!

Children and youth of all abilities and exceptionalities can play and thrive in our Smilezones, here's a little more information about how we make that happen!



INTEGRATED MURALS FOR THERAPY GOALS

Whether it be underwater, nature, or up in space, every Smilezone has a unique **theme** chosen by the hospital or health centre we partner with. Through the needs assessment, our incredible Smilezone artists review and personalize all the murals, depending on the location and population served.

Inclusion is a part of our Smilezone mission, so we love to embrace wheelchairs, walkers, joint braces, medical equipment, casts, and more in each of our murals – reinventing a new "normal" so kids and youth can feel confident and inspired in their environment.

Accessibility is just as important to our team, that's why our research-tested paint colours ensure not to overstimulate individuals with autism or other sensory disorders, and has proven to be therapeutic for children and youth in many diverse settings.

Inpatient and outpatient appointments can be an intimidating experience for a child. That's why many of our murals provide a **visual sequence** for a certain life skill or new experience. Whether it be something as simple as washing your hands, or more challenging like getting a needle, our murals help depict visual symbols and cues for kids so they are easier to understand and prepare for.

Our murals can also be designed to provide distraction-based activities for children, lessening a sometimes scary or painful experience. Activities such as I-spy and mazes can be incorporated into the murals, providing a distraction during casting, needles, or other treatment procedures.



INCLUSIVE PLAY

Including different sensory items and activities helps to stimulate a child's senses, allowing them to explore and have fun in their environment. Sensory play is a great way to distract or de-escalate kids during their clinic visits or hospital stays, positively redirecting their attention and energy.

Sensory items can also be integrated in a child's therapy goals. Our team works closely with therapists, nurses and child life specialists so we can better understand what sensory items would be most beneficial in a therapeutic context.

INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY

We know that innovation is key to a successful Smilezone installation, integrating new technology into our Zones to enhance the patient experience. It's incredible what technology can do these days!

Screenplay: Developed by a multidisciplinary team at the Bloorview Research Institute, Screenplay is a large projection system that children can interact with via a pressure-sensitive floor and visual screen. Screenplay is truly one of a kind, utilized in both fun and therapeutic contexts.

GestureTek: The GestureTek Cube is a compact "plug-and-play" system, turning any floor into an interactive display controlled by movement and gestures. GestureTek creates a space of imagination, increasing sensory play and motor skills through virtually playing air hockey, sliding into a pool, or transforming a magical kingdom!





IPads: iPads are an important feature in almost all of our Smilezones! Children and youth can explore fun videos and entertainment apps while they wait, communicate with others using specialized programs, and even incorporate interactive technology and educational games into their therapy sessions!

Projectors: Projectors are one of the most basic and versatile pieces of equipment in our Smilezones for multi-sensory work and play! This system can present moving images over walls and floors, creating magical backdrops that stimulate learning and engagement for children of all abilities.






