With so many capabilities, iPads ensure that children of any age, ability and diagnosis can enjoy the creativity of interactive play!

> Sensory equipment has been shown to improve mobilization, focus, communication skills, and environmental awareness in the children who use them. By incorporating an array of sensory play stimulus such as tactile panels, wall spinners sensory tables, bubble tubes and more, Smilezones encourage children of all ages and abilities to develop skills through therapeutic play.






