Mission Statement:

To make tough days a little brighter for kids receiving treatment in hospitals and health care facilities. We do this by creating accessible, engaging, and therapeutic spaces in health care and community facilities that improve the lives of children receiving medical treatment and support across Canada.

Brief History:

Smilezone Foundation was founded in 2012 by former NHL player Adam Graves and business leader Scott Bachly, inspired by a shared vision to improve the healthcare experience for children. Initially approached to support a local hospital space, they quickly realized the widespread need for cheerful, healing environments across Canada.

Smilezone has transformed 450 spaces into Smilezones across Canada, benefiting over 96 communities and reaching hundreds of thousands of children, parents, health care workers and families. Each Smilezone is thoughtfully designed to reduce stress and anxiety, using vibrant murals, sensory tools, and interactive technology to turn medical spaces into environments of hope, comfort, and joy.

BMO Financial Group has been a dedicated champion of Smilezone Foundation since day one, proudly serving as our founding donor partner. Their landmark \$1 million gift in 2014 helped establish our first Smilezones at Erin Oak Kids Centre for Treatment and Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital. Key Programs and initivatives

Smilezones:

At the heart of Smilezone Foundation's mission is the creation of "Smilezones" – custom-designed, child-friendly spaces that transform hospital and healthcare environments into comforting, engaging areas for children and their families. Each Smilezone is tailored to the unique needs of the healthcare setting and includes vibrant murals, sensory equipment, technology stations, and therapeutic play features.

These zones are designed to ease the stress of medical visits, reduce anxiety, and promote emotional well-being by providing children with a place to laugh, play, and feel safe during difficult times. To date, Smilezone has transformed over 450 zones across Canada, making a meaningful difference in the lives of thousands of children receiving medical care.

Annual Fundraisers:

Smilezone Foundation proudly hosts three flagship fundraising events each year, which are instrumental in supporting the creation and maintenance of Smilezones across the country:

Smilezone Foundation Annual Golf Tournament:

Now in its 11th year, our Celebrity Golf Tournament continues to be one of our most anticipated and successful annual events. In 2024, the tournament was held at Lionhead Golf Club in Brampton, ON, where it sold out once again filling all foursomes and welcoming over 350 golfers across the Masters and Legends courses. Each group was joined by a celebrity guest, making for a truly unforgettable experience both on and off the course. The 2024 event alone raised over \$350,000, contributing to an outstanding total raised over the years.

We're proud to receive outstanding media coverage each year, including national and local outlets such as TSN and Sportsnet. In 2024, TSN broadcasted live on-site, hosted their morning show, and interviewed many of our celebrity guests throughout the day. This coverage, along with additional media features, resulted in over 16 million earned media impressions, significantly amplifying awareness of our mission and impact.

Over the years, we've welcomed an incredible lineup of celebrity guests, including hockey legends like Paul Henderson, Adam Graves, Doug Gilmour, and Darcy Tucker; current NHL stars such as Ryan O'Reilly, Sean Monahan, and Anthony Cirelli; and Olympic champions like Renata Fast, Victoria Bach, Emma Maltais, and Megan Bozek. Media personalities and sports figures like Ron MacLean and Elliotte Friedman have also joined us, adding to the electric atmosphere of the day.







Key Programs and initivatives

Hockey Helping Kids Tournament:

Our Hockey Helping Kids Tournament hosted by two-time Stanley Cup winner Adam Graves is now heading into its 10th year in 2025; it has become a community favourite. Held at Joshua's Creek Arenas in Oakville, the 2024 event featured 14 sold-out teams across both men's and women's divisions, with more than 200 local players, 14 celebrity pro players, and over 50 volunteers.

The tournament raised over \$200,000, all in support of building new Smilezones in hospitals and health centres across the country. We have welcomed celebrity pros such as Mike Gartner, Colton Orr, Bernie Nicholls, Rick Vaive, Megan Bozek and many more! It's a day packed with fast-paced fun and heart, and we're thrilled to be celebrating a decade of impact this year.







Smile Bowl presented by Hamilton Tiger-Cats

The newest addition to Smilezone Foundation's annual fundraising events, in partnership with the Hamilton Tiger-Cats Smile Bowl is a fun-filled, family-friendly bowling tournament designed to bring communities together in support of children's health. Participants form teams, enjoy themed lanes, prizes, and entertainment, all while raising funds to create more Smilezones across Canada. What is Smilezone Foundation?

Smilezone Foundation is a registered children's charity, based in Oakville, Ontario committed to putting smiles on kids' faces. The Foundation's mission is to make tough days a little brighter for kids receiving treatment in hospitals and healthcare facilities. We do this by creating fun and engaging "Smilezones" in existing healthcare spaces that harness the uplifting power of a smile for kids and their families.

How did Smilezone Foundation get started?

Smilezone Foundation was established in Oakville, Ontario in 2012 when founders Adam Graves and Scott Bachly were approached to make a financial contribution to the construction of a local hospital. The request made Adam and Scott realize they wanted to make a difference, not only in their community but in communities across the country. As fathers themselves, they wanted to give children a place to experience a break from their day-to-day challenges; simply, a place that would put a smile on a kid's face! This determination led to the creation of the Smilezone Foundation.

What is a Smilezone?

A Smilezone provides a bright, fun, and comforting space in a healthcare centre for children and their families to enjoy. Smilezones transform clinical settings like hospitals, rehab centers, mental health clinics, autism treatment centers, and Children's Aid Societies into warm, inviting spaces where children can freely express themselves, unwind, and receive support in a secure environment. Each Smilezone is fully customized based on the needs of the children and families using the space regularly. The spaces offer inclusive and interactive opportunities to children of all abilities by incorporating accessible technology and sensory experiences. The Foundation has transformed over 450 spaces into Smilezones across Canada, benefiting over 96 communities and reaching more than 360,000 children annually.

Who is Involved with Smilezone Foundation?

Smilezone Foundation is led by a volunteer Board of Directors, comprising fourteen dedicated professionals who deeply support the Foundation's mission and vision. Additionally, there are four staff members responsible for the Foundation's development, operation, and administration. Together with partners and volunteers, Smilezone Foundation brings hope and resilience to children and families during difficult times.

What is the Smilezone installation process?

Each Smilezone is fully customized with our hospital partners to ensure smile satisfaction. We prioritize a collaborative and client-centred approach in designing each Smilezone. Our team works closely with the hospital's clinical staff to identify and address the needs of children and families who use the space. After months of planning, the transformation process, from planning to execution, happens over one weekend, astonishing children, families, and staff with the changes that come Monday morning.

How much does it cost to build a Smilezone?

Smilezone Foundation truly believes that you cannot put a price on a smile. Costs for Smilezones vary depending on the partner facility's needs and scope of work, the Foundation works with local funders to set a budget ensuring every child can smile when visiting.

Where does Smilezone Foundation receive funding from?

Donations make a huge impact. Smilezone Foundation relies on individual donors' and corporate supporters' generous financial support. Additionally, the Foundation raises funds by hosting special events throughout the year, including our annual Smilezone Foundation Celebrity Golf Tournament and Smilezone Hockey Helping Kids tournament.

Smilezone Foundation has created over 450 Smilezones in communities across Canada. Each year, more than 360,000 children and their families visit these Smilezones, bringing smiles to their faces every time they walk through the door.
