What is a Smilezone?

A Smilezone is a vibrant, custom-designed space in hospitals and healthcare centers, created to bring comfort and joy to children and families during challenging times. Typical features include fresh paint, colorful murals, new furniture, and permanent installations like sensory activities, interactive projectors, and gaming stations. Designed to be inclusive and accessible, Smilezones transform areas like waiting rooms, playrooms, and treatment spaces. Best of all, these transformations are completed in just one weekend, ensuring minimal disruption and a lasting positive impact.




